Directions To The Conference

The **2010 Calumet Heritage Conference** is being held in the Harre Student Union located on the campus of Valparaiso University at 1700 Chapel Drive, in Valparaiso, Indiana. (Maps and directions at <http://www.valpo.edu/maps/>)

From NW Indiana: From I-65: Exit at US-30 East in Merrillville. Proceed approximately 12 miles east to Valparaiso. You will see the US-30 entrance to the University on the left (on the north side of US-30), leading towards the Chapel. You may also continue past this entrance and then turn left at the Sturdy Road stoplight at the edge of campus

From Illinois: From I-80/90 or I-94: Exit at IN-49 South in Chesterton. Proceed approximately 8 miles south to Valparaiso, then exit onto US-30 West. After passing through the second stoplight, you will see the entrance to campus on your right.
